

Field Day on Cashew

ICAR-Krishi Vigyan Kendra (Dakshina Kannada) Mangaluru organized a field day on integrated management of stem and root borer in cashew on 01.02.2023 at Mundooru Village of Puttur Taluk. Dr. Kedarnath, Scientist (Plant Protection) briefed about the effectiveness of technology i.e. application of Chlorpyriphos 50% EC @ 0.2% solution

Swabbed over the chiselled portion and sprayed to the bore holes and then capping with mud (During November) followed by soil drenching with Chlorpyriphos 50% EC @ 0.2% solution near the root zone on CSRB management. Results indicated that the percent recovery from infestation was higher in demo plots (47.39 %) as compared to farmers practices. Dr. Rashmi, Scientist (Horticulture) and 38 farmers were participated in the programme.



Field Day in Arecanut

ICAR-Krishi Vigyan Kendra (Dakshina Kannada) Mangaluru organized a field day on integrated spindle bug management in arecanut on 02.02.2023 at Barimaru Village, Bantwal Taluk. Dr. Kedarnath, Scientist (Plant Protection) briefed about the management of spindle bug in arecanut and effectiveness of the technology i.e foliar application of Thiamethoxam 25% WG (0.25 g per litre water) in and around the spindle and inner whorl of leaves showed the highest (89.90%) mortality of spindle bug as compared to farmers practices. Dr. Mallikarjuna, L., Scientist (Soil Science) explained about the improved cultivation practices in arecanut. Mr. Vishwanath Poojary provided feedback about the effectiveness of the technology. Total 14 famers were participated in the programme.
